

How to Access IRStats

What is IRStats?

IR-Stats is a statistical reporting tool that is designed to work on EPrints repositories such as WRaP.

The guide below will get you started, but please contact wrap@worc.ac.uk if you require any further advice or information.

How to Access the service.

In a web browser goto <http://eprints.worc.ac.uk/cgi/stats/report>

This will take you to a summary page showing a range of measures over the period March 2007 - present:

- Total downloads - by month
- Total number of items in WRaP
- Total number of downloads
- % of items with full text
- % of items which are open access (#)
- A list of the most downloaded items
- A list of most downloaded authors

(#) "Open access" here means the full text is freely available but does not imply compliance with HEFCE requirements.



Using Filters

1. Select the 'Filter' tab
2. The default filter is 'Author', clicking the arrow to the right of the filter selection gives a dropdown menu of possible filters:
 - **Authors:** you will be offered suggestions as you type
 - **Subjects:** select from the dropdown menu
 - **University Structure:** select from the dropdown menu
 - **Item type:** select from the dropdown menu
 - **EPrint ID:** only of use if you know the system ID number for an item

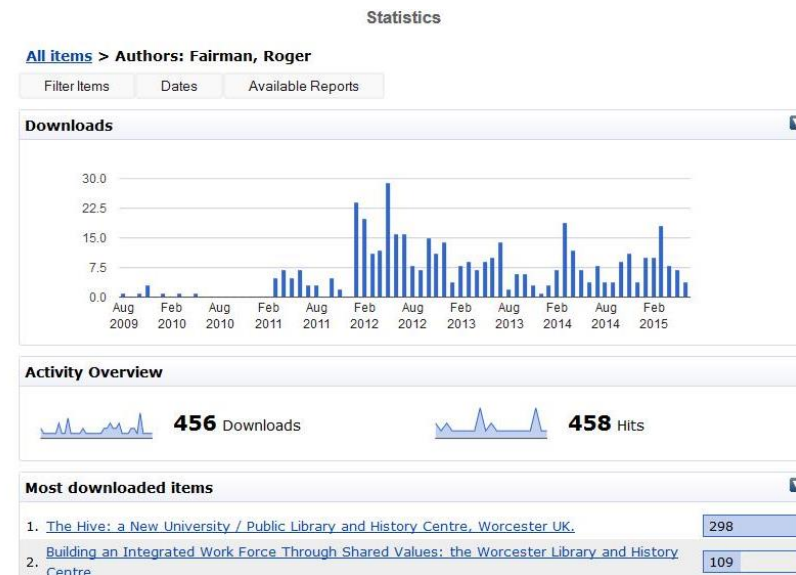


Result of an Author search:

Downloads = no. of successful downloads of the full text.

Hits = no. of times the item home page is accessed.

Nb! - The number of **downloads** can be significantly higher than the number of **hits** as a result of search engines directing users directly to the full text and by-passing the item home page.



Selecting Date Ranges

1. Select the 'Dates' tab
2. This offers the options to:
 - Select custom dates using dropdown calendars or
 - Select from a dropdown list of pre-determined date ranges.
3. Having made your selection click the 'View' button

Selecting a Report Type

Having selected the data you want there are six styles of report available from the 'Available Reports' tab:

- Summary (the default option)
- A year by year comparison (where the date range selected exceeds one year)
- Most popular author (by downloads)
- Most popular work (by downloads)
- Requests made (by geographical origin)
- Deposits made

All reports have a dropdown menu in the top right, indicated by a 'down arrow' which offers three options for downloading the data: XML, JSON & CSV.

Downloads

'Requests' report for an author.

The report gives an interactive map, which reports a download figure for each country as it is pointed to with the mouse.

Tables are also given for:

- The top referring agents - Google is commonly top of the list.
- Top browsers used to access the item
