

How to Access IRUS-UK

What is IRUS-UK?

WRaP is a participating repository in [IRUS-UK](#), a JISC funded initiative which facilitates the compilation of standardised statistics on downloads of the material held in institutional repositories. This allows institutions to both monitor the number of times any deposited item is downloaded, and compare their total figures with those of other participating institutions.

IRUS-UK is funded by JISC as part of [UK RepositoryNet+](#) (RepNet). The project is being developed by a consortium involving Mimas, Cranfield University and Evidence Base.

IRUS (Institutional Repository Usage Statistics) enables UK Institutional Repositories (IRs) to share and expose statistics based on the [COUNTER](#) standard. It will provide a nation-wide view of UK repository usage to benefit organisations such as Jisc, it will offer opportunities for benchmarking and act as an intermediary between UK repositories and other agencies.

IRUS-UK collects raw usage data from UK IRs and processes these data into COUNTER-compliant statistics. This provides repositories with comparable, authoritative, standards-based data.

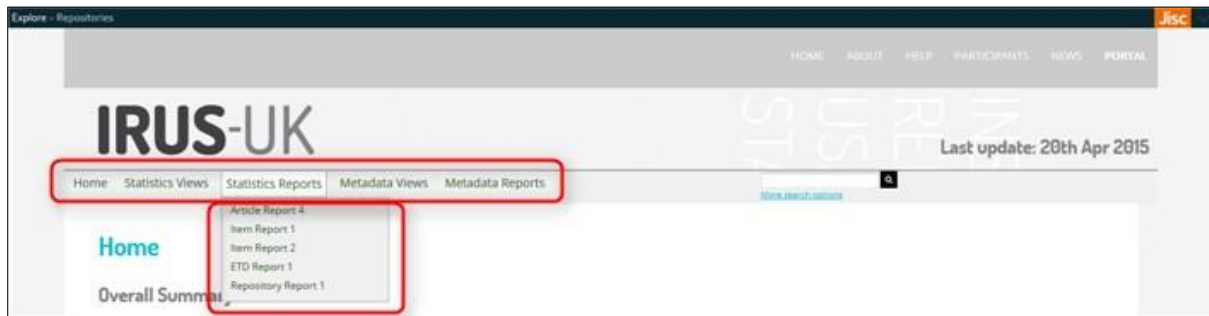
How to Access the service.

1. In a web browser goto <http://www.irus.mimas.ac.uk/>
2. Select '**PORTAL**' from the options on the top right of the page



3. Type '**Worcester**' into the search box and select 'University of Worcester' from the options given
4. Login using your usual University of Worcester username & password
5. The ribbon highlighted in the image below gives you access to a range of reports





6. The Dropdown menu under 'Statistical Reports' lists

- **Article Report 4:-** *"This report enables you to view the number of successful article downloads by month for participating repositories. The report can be filtered to limit the results to a selected journal or repository."*
- **Item Report 1:-** *"This report provides the number of successful item download requests by month and repository identifier for a selected repository."*
- **Item Report 2:-** *"This report provides the number of successful item download requests by month and item type for a selected repository."*
- **ETD Report 1:-** *"This report provides the number of successful thesis or dissertation download requests by month and repository identifier for a selected repository"*
- **Repository Report 1:-** *"This report enables you to view the number of successful item downloads by month for all participating repositories. The report can be filtered to limit the results to a selected item type, Jisc Band and/or Country"*
